INTELLIGENT STYLING TIPS

- 1 Apply Neuro™ Protect – HeatCTRL® Iron Hairspray to dry hair for thermal protection.
- 2 Determine where you want the curls to start. If you want curls from scalp to ends, place the base of the iron close to the head and begin wrapping the hair around it. If you want to curl half the strand, begin wrapping at mid-length.
- 3 Wrap the hair **OVER** the iron for more wave, or **UNDER** the iron for more bounce and lift.
- 4 Wrap larger sections for looser, wavier looks; smaller sections for tighter curls.
- 5 Choose the right Paul Mitchell® Pro Tools™ brush for your desired end result:
 - 413 Sculpting Brush for full, bouncy curls
 - Teasing Brush for a soft, Hollywood glam look
 - Detangler Comb for a free, tousled look
- 6 To set your look, spray hair with Neuro™ Finish – HeatCTRL® Style Spray.



ANATOMY OF INTELLIGENT STYLING

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Press the power button to light up all buttons, press it again to lock the touch buttons or it will lock itself after 3 seconds without operation. Quickly press to unlock it and hold the power button to turn off the iron.
- 2 Touch “M” to adjust between auto-shut off Time, Centigrade and Fahrenheit; touch “+/-” to increase or decrease while at Time or Temperature settings. To set temperature, touch + and - button to select (160-450F):
 - 160-370F for fine hair
 - 380-390F for medium hair
 - 400-450F for coarse hair/professional use
- 3 Before curling, slide the lock/unlock switch down into the unlocked position. The comb will automatically release from the barrel to better grip the hair, preventing it from slipping from around the barrel while also controlling frizzy, unruly textures.



For styling without the comb, slide the lock/unlock switch up into the locked position. Shift the lever to the left. The comb will retract into the barrel, leaving a styling rod for creating natural-looking curls.

WARNINGS:

- **Do not touch comb while rod is turned on.**
- **Do not manually force the comb in or out of the rod.**
- **While in use avoid touching the skin/scalp directly.**

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING.

DANGER – Any appliance is electrically live, even when the switch is off. When not in use, always unplug the iron to prevent the risk of fire.

WARNING – To reduce the risk of burns, electrocution, fire or injury to persons and/or personal property:

- Use the iron only for the purpose described in this guide to prevent accidents, damage or malfunction.
- This appliance should never be left unattended when plugged in.
- Avoid multiple cables to a plug or use of an extension cord to prevent starting a fire from overheating.
- KEEP AWAY FROM WATER to prevent fire, electric shock, damage or malfunction.
- KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN.
- Do not handle the iron or cord with wet hands, as this may cause electric shock.
- Do not leave the iron in a position where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- DO NOT WRAP THE CORD AROUND THE IRON.
- Never place or insert objects on iron barrel, due to the risk of causing fire, accidents or malfunction.
- Do not operate where oxygen is being administered to avoid the risk of fire.
- DO NOT USE WHEN CORD HAS BEEN DAMAGED OR IF PLUG IS LOOSE.
- DO NOT REPAIR, TAMPER WITH, OR TRY TO RECONSTRUCT the iron, otherwise electric shock, malfunction or accidents may result.
- When inserting or pulling out the plug, hold the plug firmly to prevent the cord from peeling and to prevent accidents or malfunction.
- Stop using immediately if you smell an offensive odor. If ignored, it could cause a fire or other accidents.
- Do not keep the iron in a damp place, such as a bathroom, or it may malfunction.
- Stop using the iron and remove from the power source when there is an earthquake or thunder.
- Unplug the iron from the power source when cleaning or wiping to prevent fire or electric shock.

MAINTENANCE

Daily Maintenance: For the safe use of the iron, check the following daily:

- Check the cord and surface of the cord. Never use if any parts are cracked, split, torn or damaged.
- Check the plug and never use if it is cracked, split or damaged.
- Check the plug pins and never use if transformed or damaged.
- Check the controller and do not use if cracked, split, broken or damaged.
- When not in use, clean and dry the entire iron and store in a cool, dry place.

When ready to use, follow the directions for daily maintenance.

Daily Cleaning: To keep barrel clean, unplug the iron from the power source, and once the iron is cool, wipe down barrel after each use with a hot, damp towel.

WARNING: Do not wipe the iron with thinner, benzene, gasoline, lamp oil, and other solvents or chemicals, as that may cause accidents or malfunction, and may damage the iron and void the warranty.

Defects and Malfunction:

- Read all contents of the warranty completely and carefully before contacting the salon, the distributor or our Paul Mitchell® Pro Tools™ Warranty Center.
- John Paul Mitchell Systems® is not responsible for damage caused by misuse or due to operator accidents, such as dropping the appliance on the floor.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The iron has reached your selected temperature when the display screen reaches the desired temperature. Once you have finished styling, turn off and unplug the iron. This iron has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). As a safety feature, this plug will fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit securely, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.

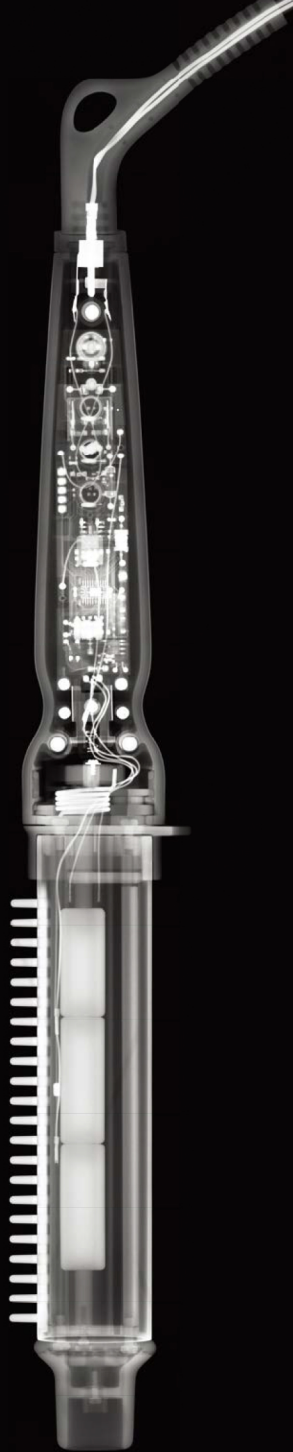
